To qualify, students must meet specific criteria, including being a Florida resident for tuition purposes and having a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

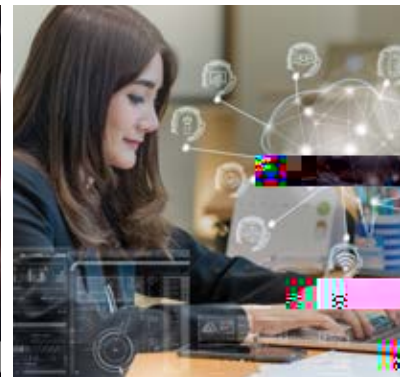
